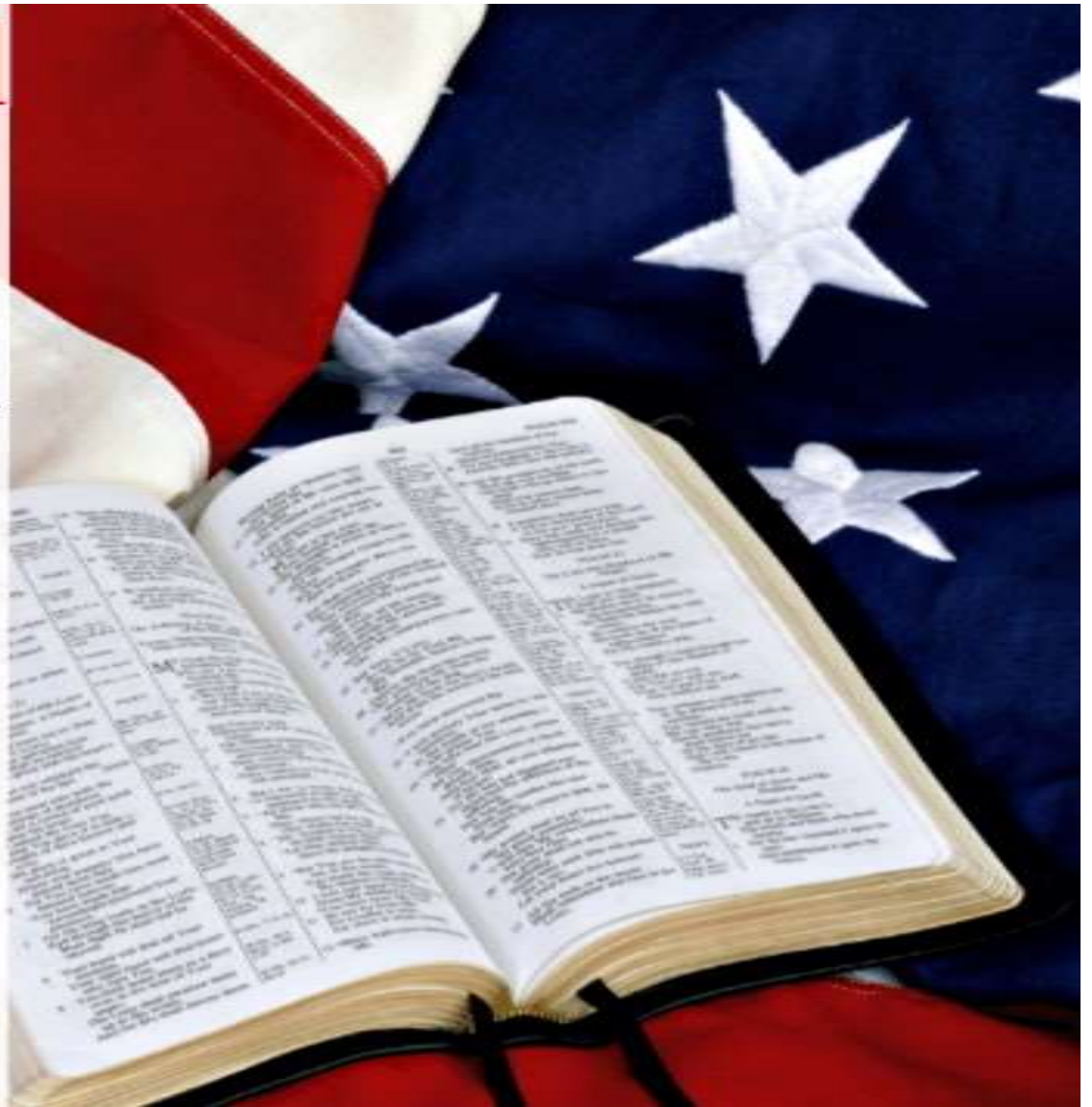

In 1998, *The Wall Street Journal* and NBC News asked several hundred young Americans to name their most important values. Work ethic led the way—[naturally](#). After that, large majorities picked patriotism, religion, and having children.

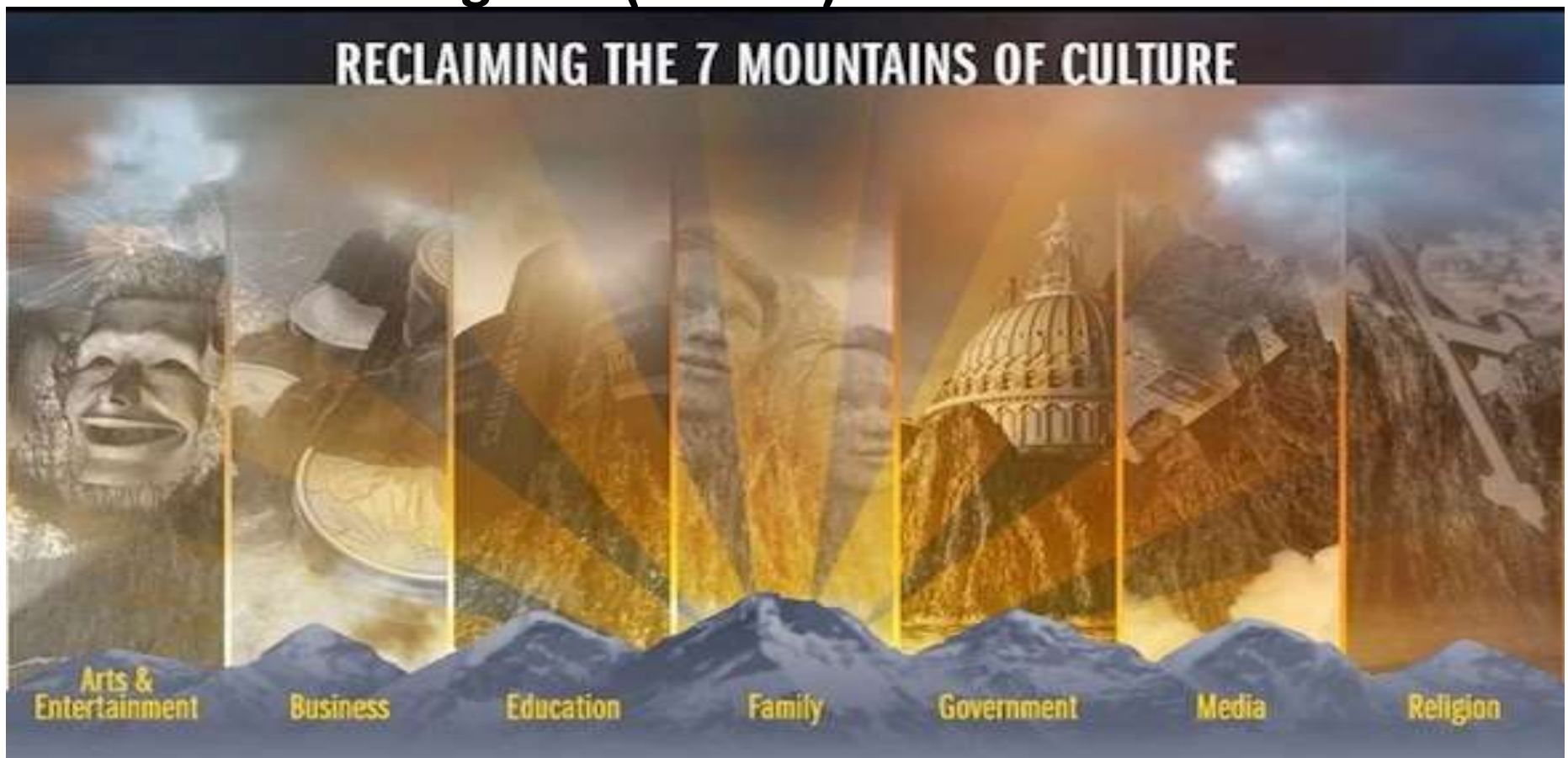
Twenty-one years later, the same pollsters asked the same questions of today's 18-to-38-year-olds. 10 percentage points less likely to value having children and 20 points less likely to highly prize patriotism or religion.

“Our research provides quantitative evidence for what we all can see in the media landscape: Journalism in the U.S. has become more subjective and consists less of the detailed event- or context-based reporting that used to characterize news coverage,” says Jennifer Kavanagh, lead author of the report and senior political scientist at RAND.

RAND Corporation, a California-based non-profit, non-partisan think tank and its recent report around objectivity, or lack thereof, in American media today.

The RAND report isn't some snapshot of a week or a month of watching cable news, either. Researchers analyzed content from 15 print and television outlets nearly three decades (1989 to 2017).
